



How do I register my child for dance classes?

How long is a dance season?

Our dance season is 10 months long and runs like a school year (late August through mid-June). We also offer a summer session (5 to 6 weeks long, starting in July).

How often do dance classes meet?

Classes meet once per week. Please refer to our dance schedule for class days and times.

How much do classes cost?

Refer to the tuition chart posted on our class schedule. Payments can be made via "autopay", online, or in the office. We accept cash, check, Visa, Mastercard and Discover.

Where do I park and enter the studio?

Our parking and entrance are around the back of our building (north side). Parents, please **wait outside** the building with your child **until they are invited in for class**.

Do parents get to stay and watch dance classes?

Our dance classes are closed to visitors. Tiny Tot and Kindergarten parents may be given a Zoom code to watch their child's class for the first few weeks of the new dance session.

How are dancers dismissed from class?

Dancers will be dismissed one at a time. Parents, please wait outside for your dancer. If someone who is unfamiliar to our staff will be picking up your child, be sure to inform the office.

What should my child wear to class?

Refer to our "Dress Code" chart found on our website. You are welcome to look through our "take and trade" bins for dance shoes before purchasing new ones. Dancers will also need to bring a small duffle bag of dance bag to class.

Where can I purchase dance clothes and shoes?

Some Dress Code items are available to purchase at the Studio (refer to our website). Shoes can be purchased online at discountdance.com. You can also try Target, Walmart or Amazon. Dancers are **REQUIRED** to be in proper Dress Code each week for class!

Can my dancer bring water to class?

Yes. Dancers are allowed to bring a non-leaking, labeled water bottle to class. No other drinks or food are allowed in the reception areas or dance studios. "After school snacks" need to be finished outside. (Tiny Tots, it's best to take a sip of water outside and leave your water bottle with your parent!)

What if my dancer can't make it to a class?

Please notify the office if your child will not be in class due to illness, travel, etc. In some cases, a make-up class is available.

Will there be performance opportunities for my dancer?

Yes! We put on a Holiday Show in December, and a year-end Recital in June. (Additional costs apply.)
