

**How do I register my child for dance classes?**

**How long is a dance season?**

Our dance season is 10 months long and runs like a school year (September through June). We also offer a summer session (5 to 6 weeks long, starting in July).

**How often do dance classes meet?**

Classes meet once per week. Please refer to our dance schedule for class days and times.

**How much do classes cost?**

Refer to the tuition chart posted on our class schedule. Payments can be made via "autopay", online, or in the office. We accept cash, check, Visa, Mastercard and Discover.

**Where do I park and enter the studio?**

Our parking and entrance are around the back of our building (north side). Enter the studio in Suite 106.

**Do parents get to stay and watch dance classes?**

Our dance classes are closed to visitors. Tiny Tot and Kindergarten classes can be viewed through a TV monitor at the "store front" (south side) of our building. We offer a "sneak peek week" to visitors in February.

**When should I drop off my child for class?**

Dancers can be dropped off 5 to 10 minutes prior to class. Supervision is not available earlier than this.

**Can I wait in the reception area while my child dances?**

Our reception areas are reserved only for dancers who are arriving for class. Our space is very limited, and not large enough to accommodate parents for the duration of a dance class.

**How are dancers dismissed from class?**

Dancers will be dismissed, one at a time, out our exit door (Suite 105). Parents, please wait outside for your dancer. If someone who is unfamiliar to our staff will be picking up your child, be sure to inform the office.

**What should my child wear to class?**

You are welcome to look through our "take and trade" bins for dance shoes before purchasing new ones. Dancers will also need to bring a small duffle bag of dance bag to class.

**Where can I purchase dance clothes and shoes?**

Dress Code items can be found at Discount Dance Supply in La Mesa, or on their website at [discountdance.com](http://discountdance.com). You can also try Target or Amazon. (It's ok if your child doesn't have all items for their first class!)

**Can my dancer bring water to class?**

Yes. Dancers are allowed to bring a non-leaking, labeled water bottle to class. No other drinks or food are allowed in the reception areas or dance studios. "After school snacks" need to be finished outside.

**What if my dancer can't make it to a class?**

Please notify the office if your child will not be in class due to illness, travel, etc. In some cases, a make-up class is available.

**Will there be performance opportunities for my dancer?**

Yes! We put on a Holiday Show in December, and a year-end Recital in June. We also perform at some local school carnivals and the San Diego County Fair. (More info available as performances approach.)
